STEP INTO THE BOOTS OF A RANGER

LEARN WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A TEXAS RANGER at the Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum Camp Friday, June 26 from 8 AM to 4 PM. SUMMER YACHT CRUISES ON THE BRAZOS

CRUISES ON THE 51-FOOT SEA RAY YACHT, "SIC'EM OR SWIM" include views of historic bridges, Baylor University waterfront, McLane Stadium and the cliffs of Cameron Park. While the yacht is available for private charters including sailgating at McLane Stadium, public cruises will be offered three times per month. Up to 25 people can enjoy a scenic sunset cruise, full moon cruise, or daytime cruise set against Waco's most picturesque backdrops.

This summer, the vessel will move from Manny's Restaurant to a new landing and beer garden on the river behind the Clifton Robinson Baylor University Tower. According to owners Michael Wilson and Lisa Spitz, the venue will be "an old school beer garden" with picnic tables, umbrellas, music, special events and 'parking' for guests' private boats.


