Waco hosts sporting events year-round due to its warm climate. Its central location within the state of Texas is ideal for drawing attendance from the big metro areas of the state – D/FW, Austin/San Antonio, and Houston. Waco is located on Interstate 35, the "Main Street of Texas," which runs from Laredo, TX up to Duluth, Minnesota. The area is served by American Airlines regional jets at the Waco Regional Airport.
