MAKE A MOVIE

The 48 Hour Film Project is a wild and sleepless weekend in which you and a team make a 4-7 minute movie - write, shoot, and edit - in just 48 hours.

On Friday night, teams draw a genre from a hat. They're then given a character, prop and line to include in their films. On Sunday night, in a wild dash to the drop off event, the film is turned in - and teams celebrate. The film is later screened to the public at a local theater.

For about the same price you'd pay to see a blockbuster, you can support LOCAL filmmakers and artists in a locally managed theater, feeding the Austin economy and building interest in the Texas Film Industry. Who knows? You might even shake the hand of the next Steven Spielberg or Robert Rodriguez!

Did you know that many of the 48 Hour Film Project shorts go on to win awards at film festivals around the world? Some have launched the careers of A-Listers! Martin Freeman ("The Hobbit," "Sherlock Holmes") once starred in a 48 Hour Film Project short! Several have developed films and series for Netflix and other streaming platforms.



Our own Austin alumni have been seen in films like "Alita: Battle Angel" or series such as the HBO original "Girls." Come to a screening and guess who's name or face you'll see next on the global stage!
